



Farmington Canal Heritage Trail Gap Closure Study and CTfastrak Connection Study

The public is invited to review and provide input on the draft Gap Closure Trail Study Final Report, which will be made available on the project website on Thursday January 11, 2018 at www.gapclosurestudy.com. Copies of the report are also available at Town Hall and at the Plainville Public Library. This report covers the North-South alignment that aims to close the Plainville gap in the Farmington Canal Heritage Trail. A separate report will be released at a later date for the East-West route that aims to connect Plainville to the CT *fastrak* trail in New Britain. The 30-day public comment period for this plan will begin Thursday, January 11, 2018 and will run through **Wednesday, February 14, 2018**.

A public hearing will be held on the Draft Report **Monday, February 5, 2018 at the Plainville Middle School Auditorium, 150 Northwest Drive, Plainville, CT from 6:00 – 8:00 P.M.** The public is invited to attend this hearing to learn more about the trail project and to share comments on the Draft Report. Feedback from the public hearing will help the study team shape the Final Report, and will be heard by Plainville Town Council members as they consider adopting the Final Report.
